Jean Yeung Wei-Jun is a Professor of Sociology from the National University of Singapore (NUS) Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, Director of the Centre for Family and Population Research, and a Research Leader in the Asia Research Institute at NUS.

Before joining NUS in 2008, she was at the University of Michigan and New York University. Prof Yeung is a Board of Trustee member of the Institute for Southeast Asian Studies and an international academic advisor to the Institute of Social Science Studies in Peking University. She has served on the editorial board for top ranked journals such as the *Demography*, *Journal of Marriage and Family*, and *Child Development*.

Prof Yeung was a co-principal investigator of the Panel Study of Income Dynamics, one of the longest running social science panel surveys and has advised on many international panel surveys. She has received many awards from prestigious institutions and published extensively. Her current research focuses on multiple aspects of American and Asian family demographic changes. Her recent publications include racial achievement gap, edited volumes on *Marriage in Asia*, *Asian Fatherhood*, *Transitioning to Adulthood in Asia*, *Shifting Boundaries of Care in Asia*, *Living Alone in Asia*, and *Economic Stress, Human Capital and Families in Asia*.
